

SECONDARY SCHOOL ADMISSIONS

Children born between 1 September 2012 and 31 August 2013 will start secondary school from September 2024. Parents need to apply for a Year 7 place by 31 October 2023 and children with an EHCP by 31 October 2023. You can use <u>this tool</u> to check which school are your nearest or catchment area To apply for a place at Thomas Telford School, you will need to apply to the school directly by 25 September 2023.
