Keeping Children Safe...


It's a really important priority for us, and I'm sure for you too.

You can see from the extensive information on our school website (Keeping Children Safe | Windmill Primary School) that we do a really good job of this.

We have four Designated Safeguarding Leads (DSL) in school. I am the senior DSL, Mrs Coles is the Deputy DSL, and Mrs Dexter and Mrs Peart are Assistant DSLs. We meet on Mondays to discuss which children and families are in most need of our attention and support. We regularly speak to children and ask how they are. Sometimes we share concerns with Family Connect, Telford's free, confidential service providing impartial advice and support on a full range of children's services. Family Connect aims to ensure that families are getting the right support at the right time.
