
Welcome to 2023 at Windmill!

Children and staff have made a great start, with an excellent attitude to learning and making good progress.

Talking of progress, we have started our termly progress review meetings in school this week. We monitor how well each child is doing and we identify children that we think could and should make accelerated progress with targeted support. We will invite those children to 'pre-teaching' sessions in school, which begin at 8:10am every morning. This helps those children be ready for the day and we have seen them showing improved confidence and competence in lessons when they have attended. The next round of parents' meetings are at the end of March, along with Spring reports being issued.
