Both storytelling and online safety are close to my heart because I believe in the power of both.

I remember stories told to me, especially when they were told to me with enthusiasm and when they inspired me or changed my thinking. My assembly today was about people we admire, and often the films I have watched that I have been most moved by are those based on true stories.

Online safety is so important because it's so easy to accidentally get into trouble through mistakes made online. Imagine if you ended up sharing something that you would never have chosen to make public, and before you know it, it's too late.

The best thing we can do to help children stay safe is to talk to them and encourage them to talk to us. That's the theme of this year's focus day: Safer Internet Day 2023 - UK Safer Internet Centre
