You may have seen on ClassDojo last week that we will have one Reception class next year, rather than two.

This is simply because of low birth rates in our area of Telford, and three other schools near us are reducing their intake in September too.

Whilst we would definitely prefer to have two Reception classes, we can see the positives of just having one class - just for next year, plus maybe one further year after that:

- We will have more staff available to meet the needs of our pupils
- We will have a more flexible use of space
- We will be able to get to know parents and carers of new Reception children even better than we already do

Our Nursery will still be able to accept up to 30 children in the mornings and 26 in the afternoons.
